To receive a Standard Diploma, a student must pass all portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam (NRS 389.015, 385.080) and earn 25 credits, including the following required courses:

English	4 Credits
Science	3 Credits
Mathematics	3 Credits (including Algebra I and/or Geometry)
American History	1 Credit
American Government	1 Credit
Arts/Humanities	1 Credit (includes Occupational classes)
Physical Education	2 Credits
Health	½ Credit
Computers	½ Credit
Electives	<u>9 Credits</u>
Total	25 Credits

Advanced Diploma

To receive an Advanced Diploma, a student must pass all portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam (NRS 389.015, 385.080), and earn 26 credits, including the following required courses:

Graduating Class of 2010 and after (NAC 389.663)

Must have a minimum GPA of 3.25

English	4 Credits
Science	3 Credits (including 2 lab classes)
Mathematics	4 Credits (including Algebra II)
American History	1 Credit
American Government	1 Credit
Social Studies	1 Credit
Arts/Humanities	1 Credit (includes Occupational classes)
Physical Education	2 Credits
Health	½ Credit
Computers	½ Credit
Electives	<u>8 Credits</u>
Total	26 Credits

Adjusted Diploma

To receive an Adjusted Diploma, a student must complete the goals as stated in their Individual Educational Plan. Students may not be required to pass all portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam if specifically stated in the IEP.

Certificate of Attendance

To receive a Certificate of Attendance, a student must pass all course requirements as describe above for a Standard Diploma with the exception of passing one or more portions of the Nevada High School Proficiency Exam. The term “certificate of attendance” is not equivalent to nor does it replace or include a standard diploma, advanced diploma, adjusted diploma or adult standard diploma.
