Standard Diploma

To receive a Standard Diploma, a student must earn 25 credits, including the following required courses:

English	4 Credits
Science	3 Credits
Mathematics	3 Credits (including Algebra I and/or Geometry)
American History	1 Credit
American Government	1 Credit
Arts/Humanities	1 Credit (includes Occupational classes)
Physical Education	2 Credits
Health	½ Credit
Computers	½ Credit
Electives	<u>9 Credits</u>
Total	25 Credits

Advanced Diploma

To receive an Advanced Diploma, a student must earn 26 credits, including the following required courses and must have a minimum GPA of 3.25:

English	4 Credits
Science	3 Credits (including 2 lab classes)
Mathematics	4 Credits (including Algebra II)
American History	1 Credit
American Government	1 Credit
Social Studies	1 Credit
Arts/Humanities	1 Credit (includes Occupational classes)
Physical Education	2 Credits
Health	½ Credit
Computers	½ Credit
Electives	<u>8 Credits</u>
Total	26 Credits

Adjusted Diploma

To receive an Adjusted Diploma, a student must complete the goals as stated in their Individual Educational Plan. Students may not be required to pass all portions of the End of Course Exams if specifically stated in the IEP.
