Mission Statement

Promote and provide support, education, and resources to Nevada's child care community thereby increasing the development of high-quality child care environments for providers, families, and children.

Superintendent's Highlights

Since 2003 our students in all three schools exceeded AYP, and in 2014 earned a 5 star rating in the NSPF. 100% of ECSD teachers are highly qualified, and continually monitor student achievement, and strive to improve instruction of standards to promote greater student learning. We use state of the art technologies including SmartBoards and 1:2 computers. We offer a comprehensive K-12 curriculum; and we have continued after-school tutoring programs and summer school at the three schools. We continue, for a sixth year, a 4-day school week to improve student and teacher attendance. It has been a popular success. We have a high level of parent involvement with nearly 100% of our parents attending school activities.

Goal 3: By 2015-2016, all students will reach high standards, at a minimum attaining proficiency or better in mathematics.

Objective: ECSD students will meet or exceed Mathematics status target of 90% during SY 2015-16.

District Communication Efforts

Eureka County High School:

Eureka County High School (ECHS) is the hub of one of the most historic and well-preserved small, rural communities in our state. Many ECHS students and staff members are from fourth or fifth generation Eureka families, and we enjoy a strong tradition of stability, continuity and family involvement. ECHS publishes a professional quality newsletter each month. Parents and community members have access to members of the ECHS staff as necessary, and parents have instant online access from home or work to information on student progress through a parent portal at any time.

Eureka Elementary:

Parents are communicated with on a daily basis, if necessary, through e-mails and home folders used by every teacher. Principal's Coffee meetings were offered three times to inform parents of upcoming events, curriculum changes, and state testing. Twice during the school year, parents were invited to conference with teachers regarding their students' successes.

Crescent Valley Elementary:

Parents are communicated with on a daily basis, if necessary, through e-mails and home folders used by every teacher. Principal's Coffee meetings were offered three times to inform parents of upcoming events, curriculum changes, and state

testing. A parent committee meeting was offered at least once a month to plan activities and inform parents of school happenings. Parents were involved in school board meetings via interactive video in the school board room. Twice during the school year, parents were invited to conference with teachers regarding their student's successes.
