## Food Service Department

### Eureka Elementary and Eureka High School

#### **Breakfast Program:**

- **Reduced Price Meal: \$.30      Regular Meal: \$1.50      Adult Meal: \$2.00**
- Offered at both schools in the cafeteria
- Breakfast is served from 7:10 am to 7:40 am

### Elementary School

#### **Lunch Program:**

- **Reduced Meal: \$.40      Regular Meal: \$2.00      Adult Meal: \$3.00**
- Any additional milk may be purchased for \$.25
- Snack is served from 10:15 am to 10:30 am
- Students may purchase a snack and a drink. Each item is \$.25

### High School

#### **Lunch Program:**

- **Reduced Meal: \$.40      Regular Meal: 2.50      Adult Meal: \$3.00**
- Any additional milk may be purchased for \$.25

### Returned Check Policy:

- In the event your check is dishonored or returned for any reason, you will be charged an overdraft fee of **\$25.00**, payable to Eureka County School District.

### We suggest that you prepay for meals weekly or monthly:

#### **Elementary & High School Breakfast cost per student**

- \$1.50 per day x 4 days = \$6.00 per week
- \$6.00 per week x 4 weeks = \$24.00 per month

#### **Elementary Lunch cost per student**

- \$2.00 per day x 4 = \$8.00 per week
- \$8.00 per week x 4 weeks = \$32.00 per month

#### **High School Lunch cost per student**

- \$2.50 per day x 4 days = \$10.00 per week
- \$10.00 per week x 4 weeks = \$40.00 per month

### **School Meal Charges:**

If your child owes money at the start of the school year, this is a debt from the prior year. Please pay this bill promptly. Here are all of the notification steps we will take so you and your child know when money is needed:

- The cashier will allow him/her to charge up to three meals to his/her account.
- You will be notified by e-mail or phone call.

### **Applications for Free/Reduced Meals:**

- The prior year's eligibility is good for the first 30 days of school.
- A new application must be completed and processed every year.

### **Food Allergy:**

While some allergic reactions are mild, students with severe food allergies may experience serious, potentially life-threatening reactions to eating, touching, or smelling certain foods. Please be careful not to send foods that contain allergens into the classroom. The food(s) we are especially concerned with are: **Peanut Butter and Peanuts. We encourage parents to call the school before bringing in snacks for class parties, as this will help any special needs with students in the classroom.**
